DRESS CODE

Background

The British Academy expects all students to wear their uniform with pride whether on campus or off campus. As part of our vision **to provide an excellent and respectful learning environment**, the appearance of our students and the subsequent behaviour is important in maintaining our high standards and building the culture of excellence that we strive for.

Hair

Girls Once hair is below shoulder length or deemed untidy, it must be pulled back neatly. Hair must be of the student's natural color (no highlights permitted).

Boys Hair should be kept neat at all times. If on admission the hair is below shoulder length or deemed untidy, it must be pulled back neatly. For the boys whose hair is cut above the nape of the neck on joining the school, they will maintain that length or shorter for the duration of their stay at the school. Facial hair is to be kept short and neat at all times

Jewellery

Girls Only one pair (one in each ear) is allowed. Earrings must be studs or small hoops and be worn in the first hole of the ear lobe. Necklaces, for religious purpose must be worn under the polo shirt. The school will accept no responsibility for lost or missing items of jewelry.

Boys Boys are not permitted to wear earrings to school. Necklaces, for religious purpose must be worn under the polo shirt. The school will accept no responsibility for lost or missing items of jewelry.

Nails

Boys & Girls – Nails must be kept short and neat and of a natural color. No nail varnish.

Make Up

No facial make-up will be permitted at school. Make-up and fingernail polish are not to be brought to school.
